SUBJECT: Change to Mask Policy for Lobby Viewing

With colder weather now upon us, and with our customers' safety in mind, as of October 1st, all adults and children, age 3 yrs. and older, will be required to wear masks when entering/exiting and viewing classes in our lobby, due to anticipated increases in occupancy.

We ask that all customers, please adhere to the following guidelines beginning October 1st:

We trust that all patrons will not enter our facilities if you, or any siblings with you, are experiencing symptoms related to current COVID-19 guidelines.

Gym and pool students will now enter **and exit** through the lobby. Gym students will now leave all outerwear in lobby cubbies and bring a water bottle into class with them. Gym students have the option of wearing or not wearing mask during class time.

Swimmers will start entering/exiting through the lobby as of Tuesday, 9/29. Swimmers are to arrive with swimsuits on. Parents of swimmers will keep student's outerwear with parent and only 1 family will be permitted in dressing room or restroom located in pool or lobby areas for changing after class.

We still recommend viewing without siblings, however, if it is necessary to have sibling(s) with you, all siblings are to remain close to their adult at all times.

We are still recommending only 1 parent view class due to our limited lobby space.

If you forget to bring a mask, both our North and South Gyms will have masks available for your use.

As always, we will be diligent in our disinfecting methods, and we will like to remind all to please not enter the lobby more than 5 minutes before your child's class time, and please be prompt picking students up after class, so that we can continue to disinfect before the start of each class.
